

Dear Parishioners,

I hope this message finds you well. I am writing to share some important updates regarding our pastoral staff and ministry initiatives.

It is with great joy that I announce the appointment of Fr. Cristian Valenzuela as the new parochial vicar of our pastorate, effective July 1, 2024. According to the official decree of appointment, Fr. Cristian has been assigned to the following roles:

- Parochial vicar of Holy Cross Parish, Mazomanie (with ministry limited to St. Barnabas Church, Mazomanie), St. Norbert Parish, Roxbury, and Divine Mercy Parish, Sauk City

- Chaplain of the Hispanic Catholic community for several parishes, including St. Philomena (Belmont), Our Lady of Fatima (Darlington), St. Joseph (Gratiot), St. Matthew (Shullsburg), and St. John (South Wayne)

Within our pastorate, Fr. Cristian will focus his ministry primarily at St. Barnabas Church and Divine Mercy Parish. He will also be actively involved with St. Aloysius School and our Religious Education program.

As part of the diocese's ongoing "Into the Deep" initiative, Bishop Hying has announced some changes to Hispanic ministry in our area:


Fr. Osvaldo Briones, currently serving part-time in Hispanic ministry at St. John the Baptist Parish in Waunakee, will transition to a full-time role as Chaplain to the Hispanic Community at St. Thomas Aquinas Parish in Madison, effective July 1, 2024. This change is part of a broader effort to centralize Hispanic ministry resources.

As a result, Hispanic ministry will no longer be offered at St. John the Baptist in Waunakee. St. Thomas Aquinas Parish will serve as the new centralized site for Hispanic ministry in the area, offering bilingual staff and extensive Spanishlanguage resources to serve the growing Hispanic population in Madison and neighboring communities.

Due to these changes, Fr. Osvaldo will no longer serve as a parochial vicar of our pastorate. However, he will continue to reside in the rectory at St. Aloysius Church and will assist with some pastoral duties in our community.

I ask for your prayers as we navigate these changes and for all our diocesan efforts to strengthen Hispanic Ministry, bring communities together, and draw people closer to Christ. If you have any questions or concerns, please don't hesitate to reach out to me or our parish office.


