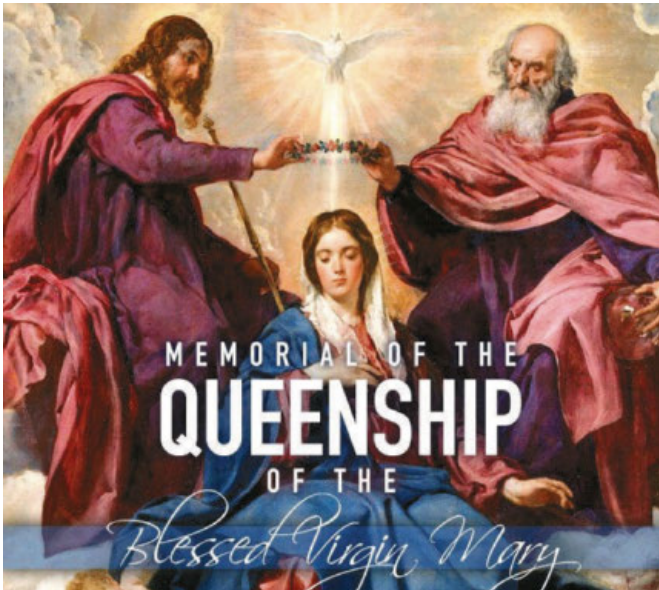

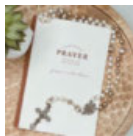
ST. NORBERT 2024-2025 ENVELOPES AVAILABLE

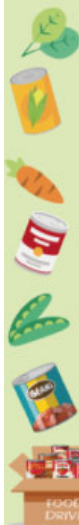
