This coming Thursday, August 15th, we celebrate the Solemnity of the Assumption of the

Blessed Virgin Mary. This is a Holy Day of Obligation, and I encourage all of you to join us for Mass as we honor Our Lady.

The Assumption is a beautiful feast that commemorates the moment when Mary, at the end of her earthly life, was taken body and soul into heaven. This dogma, defined by



Pope Pius XII in 1950, affirms our belief that Mary, as the Mother of God and as one who was preserved from original sin, did not suffer bodily decay but was assumed into heavenly glory.

This feast reminds us of the dignity of the human body and the promise of our own resurrection. It also highlights Mary's role in salvation history and her continued intercession for us. As we celebrate, let us reflect on Mary's "yes" to God and strive to imitate her faithful discipleship.


