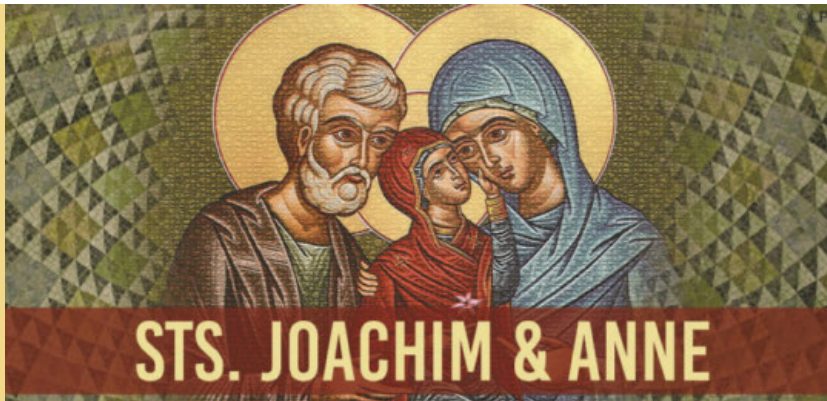

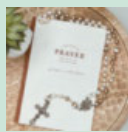

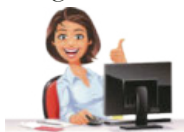
PARISH PRAYER INTENTION BOOK
