Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

As the vibrant colors of spring burst forth around us, so too does the Church turn its heart with particular devotion to the Blessed Virgin Mary throughout the blessed month of May. This tradition stretches back centuries, a testament to the deep love and respect the Catholic faithful hold for the Mother of God.

But why this special devotion to Mary? Firstly, we honor her as the chosen vessel who bore the Son of God. Through her “fiat” – her “yes” – the Word became flesh, and salvation entered our world. Secondly, we admire her unwavering faith throughout her life, from the joy of the Annunciation to the sorrow of the foot of the Cross. Her perfect obedience to God’s will serves as a constant inspiration.

However, our devotion to Mary goes beyond mere admiration. We see in her a model for our own Christian lives. She is a woman of prayer, ever interceding for us with her Son. The Rosary provides a framework for regular, contemplative prayer, allowing us to grow in our relationship with both our Lord and His Blessed Mother.

This May, I encourage you to embrace the many opportunities for Marian devotion offered here at our parish. Join us for the daily Rosary or simply take some quiet time for personal reflection on her life. May this month be a time of renewed faith, hope, and love, nourished by the gentle intercession of our Blessed Mother Mary.



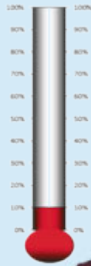
