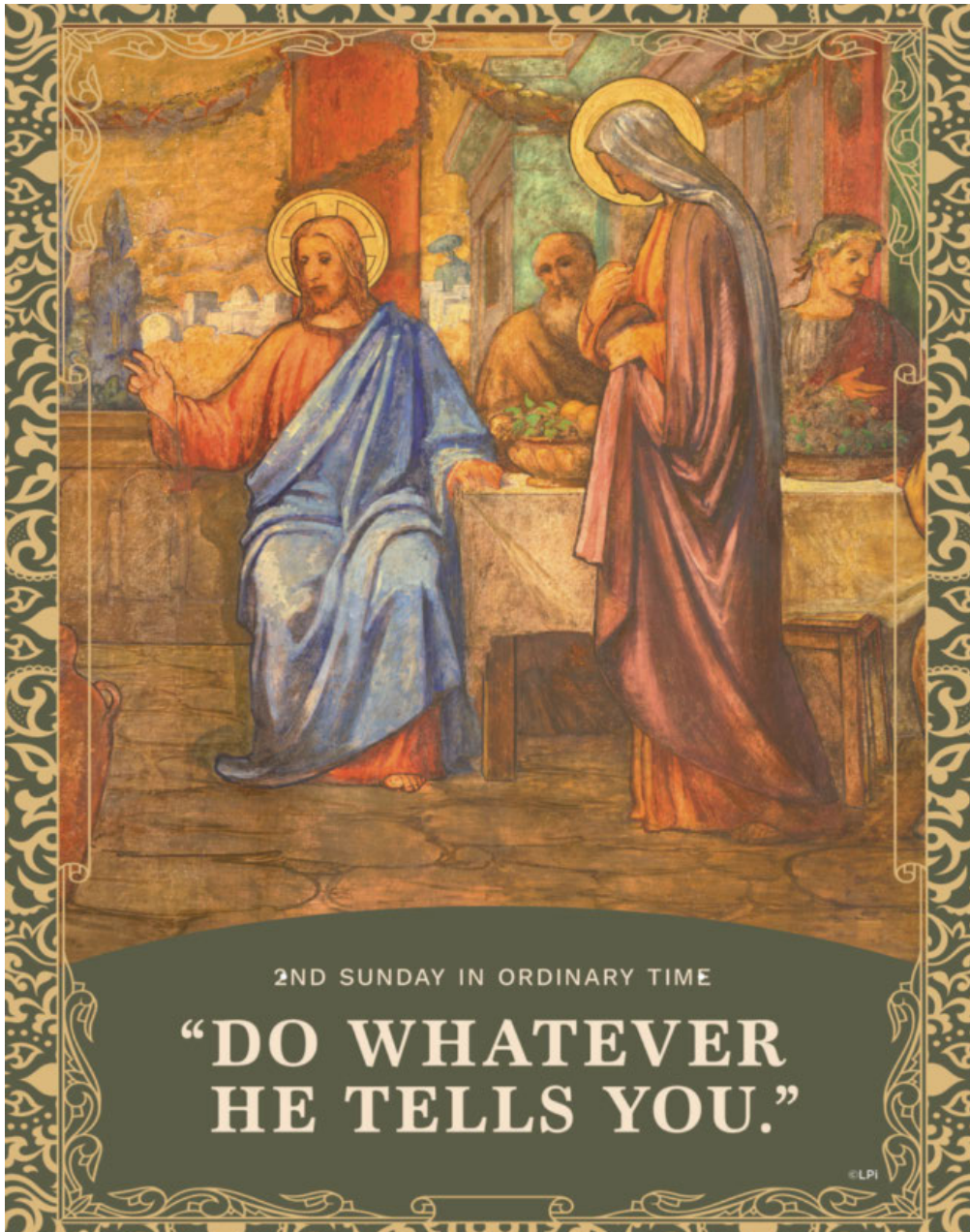

This Saturday, our 2nd graders experienced a beautiful moment of grace as they received the Sacrament of Reconciliation for the first time. **Bell Tower Update**

This is certainly a challenging undertaking, but it also opens the door to consider how we can use this project to address other potential updates to our church. While we are still in the early stages of evaluating our options, I am beginning to consider how this effort might fit into a broader vision for the care and improvement of our parish home.

I will be working with a building committee to help guide these efforts and will share more information as plans take shape. For now, I ask for your prayers for wisdom and clarity as we move forward. Thank you for your continued support and commitment to our parish. Together, we will ensure our church remains a place of beauty, strength, and faith for generations to come.

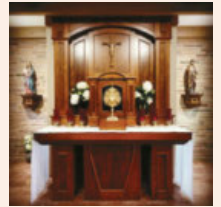

### THINGS TO DO DURING EUCHARISTIC ADORATION

Eucharistic adoration is the act of worshipping God as He is present in the consecrated Eucharist. Spending time before the Blessed Sacrament, in prayer and devotion, is exactly the same as spending time before the living God.

**-PRAY THE PSALMS OR THE LITURGY OF THE HOURS:** Whether you are praising, giving thanks, asking for forgiveness, or seeking an answer, you'll find an appropriate psalm. The ancient prayer of the Church called the Liturgy of the Hours presents an excellent way to pray through the Book of Psalms throughout the year.

**-MEDITATE USING SCRIPTURE:** Choose a passage from the Bible. Read the words and ask God to let the passage speak to you. Pay special attention to anything that strikes you and ask God what He wishes for you to draw from that passage.

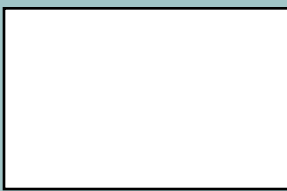
