



ble for emergencies (608-370-3751). But before I go, a couple of huge "thank you"s.


First, our new handicap ramp on the north side of the church is coming along very nicely. Thank you so much to all the members of St. Norbert (especially those of the maintenance committee, and even more especially to a certain gentleman who has made a ton of phone calls, but who wishes to remain anonymous) who have generously volunteered time and work to this endeavor. Also, we recently learned that the Apostolate for Persons with Disabilities of the Diocese of Madison has given us a grant for the ramp which will help a great deal towards the final cost. A big thank you to them as well!

Shoreless Lake School is a Catholic school belonging to the Society of Jesus Christ the Priest, a spiritual family of priests of which I have been a lifelong member. After consulting with and getting approval from the St Norbert Parish and Finance Councils, we are well underway in the process of moving our school from the old convent building at St. Alovsius to the RE Center in Roxbury. The Society of Jesus Christ the Priest has agreed to pay rent for the use for the RE Center, and to take care of the cost of renovating and refitting the building, to begin use in September of this year. The St. Norbert Finance Council has also given a substantial donation (6,000 dollars) to the Society towards necessary electrical upgrades, paint jobs and roofing issues for the RE Center. A huge thank you to all the members of St. Norbert Parish for their generosity, and for being such wonderful landlords! We very much appreciate it, and may God reward you. Also, if anyone is interested in learning more information about Shoreless Lake School, please feel free to contact Fr. Faustino or me and we would be happy to fill you in. Also, I have been assigned the task of supervising our new joint Go Make Disciples group, which will now be composed of two teams: a planning team and a hands-on or activities team. Each team will have members representing the four churches in our Pastorate. I am in the process of finalizing certain details, and by the time I get back from Spain in September I will set up a date for our first meeting. God bless, and have a wonderful rest of the summer!
