

# UPDATE TO SUGGESTED AMOUNTS FOR MASS STIPENDS

The Diocese of Madison and our parishes are grateful to all those who have generously provided a donation for Masses in the past. The donation for Mass Intentions has remained the same for thirty years throughout the dioceses of Wisconsin. Recently, when the Bishops of the State of Wisconsin gathered, they decreed that stipends should be adjusted to reflect the current time and to account for inflation. The new suggested Mass stipend is:

#### MASS STIPENDS - \$20

This new suggested Mass stipend amount takes effect with Masses that occur on or after July 1, 2024. They do not apply retroactively to those who have already paid the appropriate amount for an upcoming event (even one that falls after July 1, 2024). The new Mass stipend will be applied to all *new* requests we receive for events that occur on or after July 1, 2024.

As always, if someone is not able to offer the stipend, the parish is always happy to provide the sacrament or service with no fee.



# Please respect the following rules for the safety of those who care for our cemetery:

- Artificial flowers and arrangements are not allowed from May 15<sup>th</sup> thru November 1<sup>st</sup>. Any artificial flowers that remain after May 15<sup>th</sup> will be removed.
- \* Please do **not** insert wire or anything on wire into the ground.
- \* Seasonal flowers may be planted within 12 inches of the front or back of monuments. Please do **not** plant or place things on the **sides** of monuments.
- \* Rose bushes, miniature rose bushes, ferns, shrubs, trees or any plants that tend to spread are **not** allowed.
- \* Gravel or decorative stone for mulch is **not** allowed.
- \* Brick, stone or any type of edging is **not** allowed
- \* Vases, jars, or other objects made of glass or anything breakable are **not** allowed.

- Bird houses, bird feeders and bird baths are not allowed.
- One Plant stands/hangers/shepherd's hooks per monument. They must be removed before the ground freezes.
- \* No dumping of garbage or yard waste.
- \* No dogs allowed.
- \* Please do not shovel snow or use a snowblower at the cemetery.
- \* Everyone is responsible for their own planting, care and removal of plants.
