UPDATE TO SUGGESTED AMOUNTS FOR MASS STIPENDS

The Diocese of Madison and our parishes are grateful to all those who have generously provided a donation for Masses in the past. The donation for Mass Intentions has remained the same for thirty years throughout the dioceses of Wisconsin. Recently, when the Bishops of the State of Wisconsin gathered, they decreed that stipends should be adjusted to reflect the current time and to account for inflation. The new suggested Mass stipend is:

MASS STIPENDS - \$20

This new suggested Mass stipend amount takes effect with Masses that occur on or after July 1, 2024. They do not apply retroactively to those who have already paid the appropriate amount for an upcoming event (even one that falls after July 1, 2024). The new Mass stipend will be applied to all **new** requests we receive for events that occur on or after July 1, 2024.

As always, if someone is not able to offer the stipend, the parish is always happy to provide the sacrament or service with no fee.
