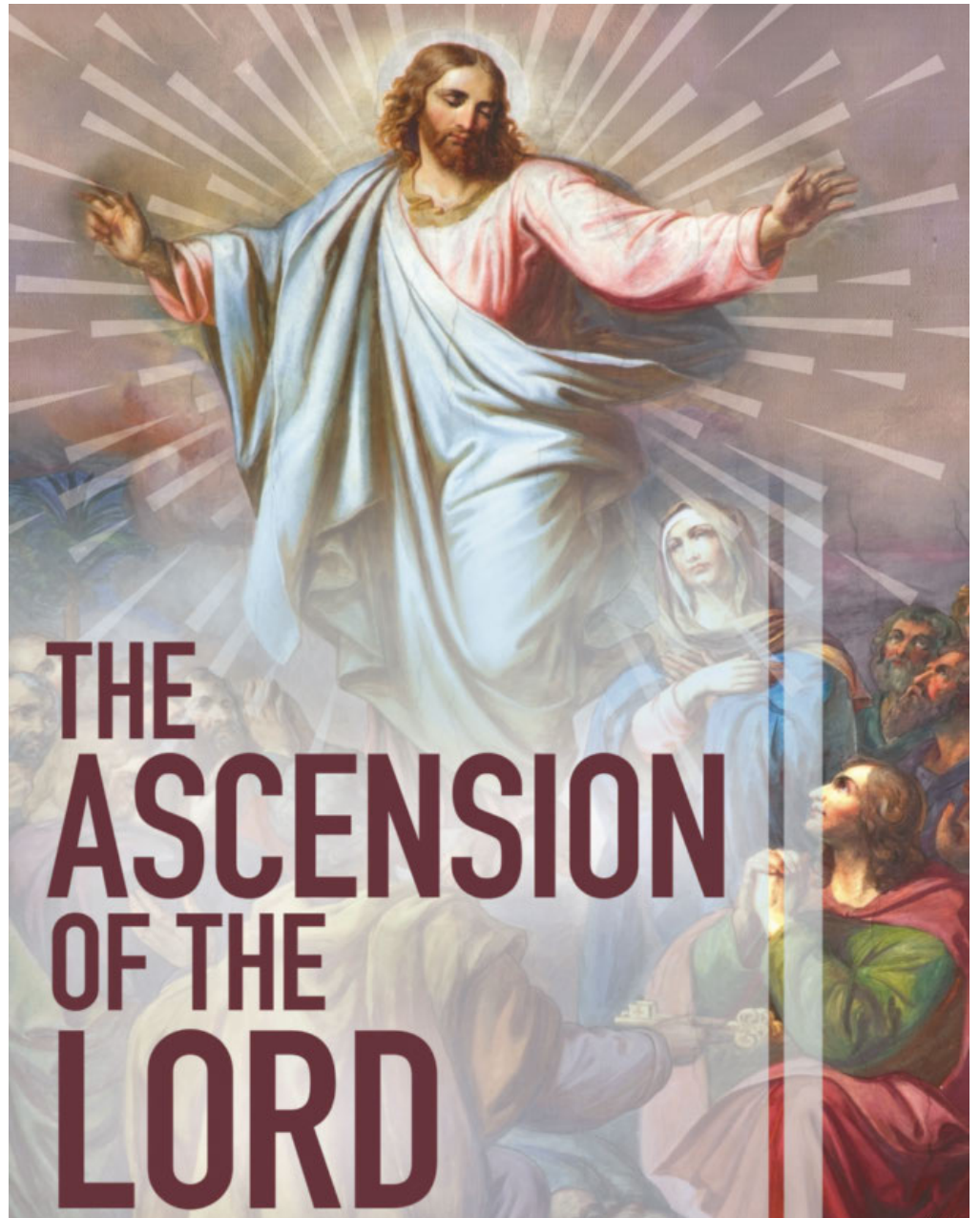

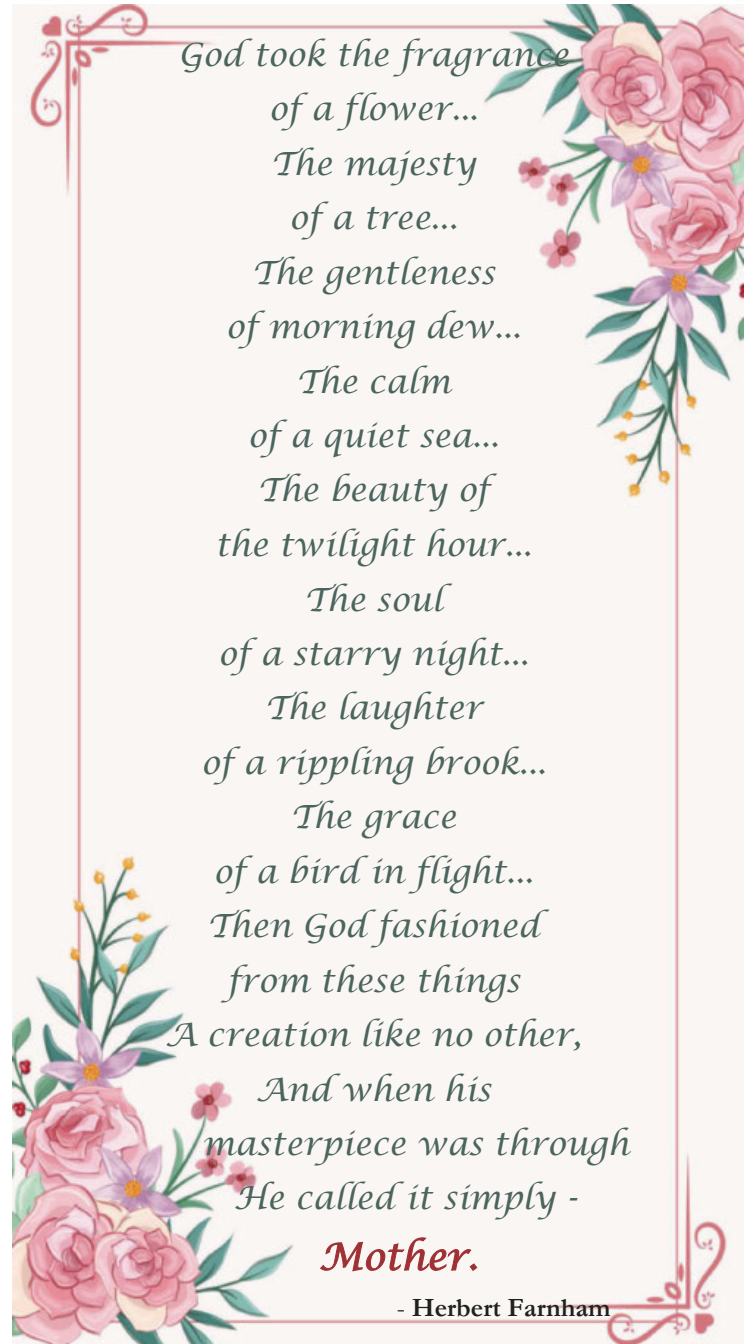
To all the mothers, both present and departed, we offer our deepest gratitude. May God bless you abundantly on your special day!

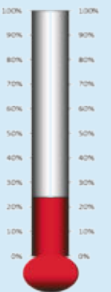
