


COFFEE AND DOUGHNUTS THIS SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 1

ST. GREGORY THE GREAT Born c. 540, Rome - Died March 12, 604, Rome Feast day, September 3.

He was the pope from 590 to 604, a reformer and excellent administrator, "founder" of the medieval papacy, which exercised both secular and spiritual power. His epithet "the Great" reflects his status as a writer as well as a ruler. As the fourth and final of the traditional Latin Fathers of the Church, Gregory was the first exponent of a truly medieval, sacramental spirituality. Saint Gregory is the patron saint of Educators, Musicians and Singers.


