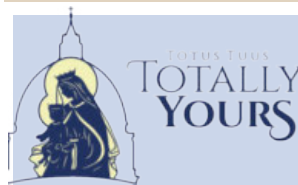


PRAYER

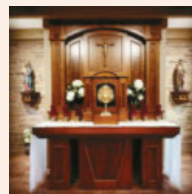

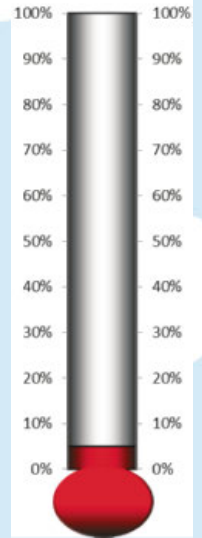

Reagan Hruby (4th) Interviewed our music teacher Mrs. Magnuson. Let's hear what she had to say!

Q: What is your favorite type of music?

My favorite music is Christian songs by artists like Lauren Daigle and Casting Crowns.

Q: Why did you start teaching music?

I started teaching music as a way to share my love for music and to foster each person's God given talents and emotions.

Q: How did you get started in music?
